THREE LIFE-GIVING DECLARATIONS

- **The first is**, "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." (Romans 5:1)
 - The declaration of our **salvation**.
- **The second is**, "Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."
 - The declaration of our **assurance**.
- **The third is**, "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters in view of **God's mercies**, to **offer your bodies** as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God -- this is your true and proper worship. **2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world**, but be transformed by the **renewing of your mind**. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is -- His good, pleasing and perfect will." (Romans 12:1-2)
