GOD, CAESAR AND THE CHRISTIAN

ROMANS 13:1-7 (ESV)

13 Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God. 2 Therefore whoever resists the authorities resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur judgment. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to bad. Would you have no fear of the one who is in authority? Then do what is good, and you will receive his approval, 4 for he is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for he does not bear the sword in vain. For he is the servant of God, an avenger who carries out God's wrath on the wrongdoer. 5 Therefore one must be in subjection, not only to avoid God's wrath but also for the sake of conscience. 6 For because of this you also pay taxes, for the authorities are ministers of God, attending to this very thing. 7 Pay to all what is owed to them: taxes to whom taxes are owed, revenue to whom revenue is owed, respect to whom respect is owed, honor to whom honor is owed.

1. WHERE DID THE IDEA OF HUMAN GOVERNMENT ORIGINATE?

ROMANS 13:1

13 Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.

GENESIS 9:1, 5-7

9 Then God blessed Noah and his sons and told them, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth.

5 "And I will require the blood of anyone who takes another person's life. If a wild animal kills a person, it must die. And anyone who murders a fellow human must die. 6 If anyone takes a human life, that person's life will also be taken by human hands. For God made human beings in his own image. 7 Now be fruitful and multiply and repopulate the earth."

2. WHAT IS GOD'S PURPOSE FOR HUMAN GOVERNMENT?

A. To Organize and Oversee Human Society v1

ROMANS 13:1

13 Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.

B. To Promote Good in Human Society vv3-4a

ROMANS 13:3-4A

3 For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to bad. Would you have no fear of the one who is in authority? Then do what is good, and you will receive his approval, 4 for he is God's servant for your good.

C. To Restrain and Punish Evil in human's society vv2-4

ROMANS 13:2-4

2 Therefore whoever resists the authorities resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur judgment. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to bad. Would you have no fear of the one who is in authority? Then do what is good, and you will receive his approval, 4 for he is God's servant for your good. 3. HOW SHOULD CHRISTIANS RESPOND TO GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY?

ROMANS 13:1

13 Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.

I PETER 2:13-17

13 Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, 14 or to governors as sent by him to punish those who do evil and to praise those who do good. 15 For this is the will of God, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people. 16 Live as people who are free, not using your

freedom as a cover-up for evil, but living as servants of God. 17 Honor everyone. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the emperor.
