2 TIMOTHY 1:8-12 (NLT)

⁸So **never be ashamed to tell others about our Lord**. And don't be ashamed of me, either, even though I'm in prison for him. **With the strength God gives you, be ready to suffer with me for the sake of the Good News.** ⁹For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was his plan from before the beginning of time—to show us his grace through Christ Jesus. ¹⁰And now he has made all of this plain to us by the appearing of Christ Jesus, our Savior. He broke the power of death and illuminated the way to life and immortality through the Good News. ¹¹And God chose me to be a preacher, an apostle, and a teacher of this Good News.

¹²That is why I am suffering here in prison. But I am not ashamed of it, for **I know the one in whom I trust**, and I am sure that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until **the day of his return**.

I. PAUL'S PRIORITIES AND PLANS 15:16-33

ROMANS 15:16-19 (NLT)

For by God's grace, ¹⁶I am a special messenger from Christ Jesus to you Gentiles. I bring you the Good News so that I might present you as an acceptable offering to God, made holy by the Holy Spirit. ¹⁷So I have reason to be enthusiastic about all Christ Jesus has done through me in my service to God. ¹⁸Yet I dare not boast about anything except what Christ has done through me, bringing the Gentiles to God by my message and by the way I worked among them. ¹⁹They were convinced by the power of miraculous signs and wonders and by the power of God's Spirit. In this way, I have fully presented the Good News of Christ from Jerusalem all the way to Illyricum.

ROMANS 15:20-22 (NLT)

²⁰ My ambition has always been to preach the Good News where the name of Christ has never been heard, rather than where a church has already been started by someone else. ²¹ I have been following the plan spoken of in the Scriptures, where it says,

“Those who have never been told about him will see,
and those who have never heard of him will understand.”

²² In fact, my visit to you has been delayed so long because I have been preaching in these places.

ROMANS 15:23-24

²³ But now I have finished my work in these regions, and after all these long years of waiting, I am eager to visit you. ²⁴ **I am planning to go to Spain**, and when I do, I will stop off in Rome. And after I have enjoyed your fellowship for a little while, you can provide for my journey.

ROMANS 15:25-29

²⁵ But before I come, I must go to Jerusalem to take a gift to the believers there. ²⁶ For you see, the believers in Macedonia and Achaia have eagerly taken up an offering for the poor among the believers in Jerusalem. ²⁷ They were glad to do this because they feel they owe a real debt to them. Since the Gentiles received the spiritual blessings of the Good News from the believers in Jerusalem, they feel the least they can do in return is to help them financially. ²⁸ As soon as I have delivered this money and completed this good deed of theirs, I will come to see you on my way to Spain. ²⁹ And I am sure that when I come, Christ will richly bless our time together.

ROMANS 15:30-31a

³⁰ Dear brothers and sisters, I urge you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to join in my struggle by praying to God for me. Do this because of your love for me, given to you by the Holy Spirit. ³¹ Pray that I will be rescued from those in Judea who refuse to obey God.

ROMANS 15:31b-32

Pray also that the believers there will be willing to accept the donation I am taking to Jerusalem. ³² Then, by the will of God, I will be able to come to you with a joyful heart, and we will be an encouragement to each other.

³³ And now may God, who gives us his peace, be with you all. Amen.

II. PAUL'S FRIENDS**16:1-16****ROMANS 16:1-2**

16 I commend to you our sister **Phoebe**, who is a deacon in the church in **Cenchrea**. ² Welcome her in the Lord as one who is worthy of honor among God's people. Help her in whatever she needs, for she has been helpful to many, and especially to me.

ROMANS 16:3-5a

³ Give my greetings to **Priscilla and Aquila**, my co-workers in the ministry of Christ Jesus. ⁴ In fact, they once risked their lives for me. I am thankful to them, and so are all the Gentile churches. ⁵ Also give my greetings to the church that meets in their home.

ROMANS 16:5b-9

Greet my dear friend **Epenetus**. He was the first person from the province of Asia to become a follower of Christ. ⁶ Give my greetings to **Mary**, who has worked so hard for your benefit. ⁷ Greet **Andronicus** and **Junia**, my fellow Jews, who were in prison with me. They are highly respected among the apostles and became followers of Christ before I did. ⁸ Greet **Ampliatius**, my dear friend in the Lord. ⁹ Greet **Urbanus**, our co-worker in Christ, and my dear friend **Stachys**.

ROMANS 16:10-16

¹⁰ Greet **Apelles**, a good man whom Christ approves. And give my greetings to **the believers from the household of Aristobulus**. ¹¹ Greet **Herodion**, my fellow Jew. Greet the Lord's people from **the household of Narcissus**. ¹² Give my greetings to **Tryphena** and **Tryphosa**, the Lord's workers, and to dear **Persis**, who has worked so hard for the Lord. ¹³ Greet **Rufus**, whom the Lord picked out to be his very own; and also **his dear mother**, who has been a mother to me.

¹⁴ Give my greetings to **Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermes, Patrobas, Hermas, and the brothers and sisters who meet with them**. ¹⁵ Give my greetings to **Philologus, Julia, Nereus and his sister, and to Olympas and all the believers who meet with them**. ¹⁶ Greet each other with a sacred kiss. All the churches of Christ send you their greetings.

III. PAUL'S FINAL WARNING

16:17-20

ROMANS 16:17-20

¹⁷ And now I make one more appeal, my dear brothers and sisters. Watch out for people who cause divisions and upset people's faith by teaching things contrary to what you have been taught. Stay away from them. ¹⁸ Such people are not serving Christ our Lord; they are serving their own personal interests. By smooth talk and glowing words they deceive innocent people. ¹⁹ But everyone knows that you are obedient to the Lord. This makes me very happy. I want you to be wise in doing right and to stay innocent of any wrong. ²⁰ The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. May the grace of our Lord Jesus^[u] be with you.

16:21-24

ROMANS 16:21-24

²¹ Timothy, my fellow worker, sends you his greetings, as do Lucius, Jason, and Sosipater, my fellow Jews.

²² I, Tertius, the one writing this letter for Paul, send my greetings, too, as one of the Lord's followers.

²³ Gaius says hello to you. He is my host and also serves as host to the whole church. Erastus, the city treasurer, sends you his greetings, and so does our brother Quartus.^[v]

ROMANS 16:25-27

²⁵ Now all glory to God, who is able to make you strong, just as my Good News says. This message about Jesus Christ has revealed his plan for you Gentiles, a plan kept secret from the beginning of time. ²⁶ But now as the prophets^[w] foretold and as the eternal God has commanded, this message is made known to all Gentiles everywhere, so that they too might believe and obey him. ²⁷ **All glory to the only wise God**, through Jesus Christ, forever. Amen.^[x]
