## ***What Christians Believe:***

- *Jesus died for our sins.*
- *Jesus was raised from the dead on the third day.*

### ***I. JESUS DIED FOR OUR SINS***

***I CORINTHIANS 15:3***

<sup>3</sup>I passed on to you what was most important and what had also been passed on to me. **Christ died for our sins**, just as the Scriptures said.

## **RIGHTEOUS – HOLY – JUST**

- No one is righteous - not even one. (Rom 3:10)
- <sup>23</sup>For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. (Rom 3:23)
- The wages (just consequence) of sin is death. (Rom 6:23)
- The person who sins is the one who will die. (Ezek 18:4)

***II PETER 3:9***

God is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to be destroyed, but wants everyone to repent.

## **What is God's solution?**

***II CORINTHIANS 5:21***

<sup>21</sup>For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin – to become sin itself - so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

***I PETER 3:18***

<sup>18</sup> Christ suffered for our sins once for all time. He never sinned, but he died for sinners to bring you safely home to God.

***EVIDENCE FOR THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST?***

**A. THE TOMB OF JESUS WAS EMPTY.**

***MATTHEW 28:11-14 (NIV)***

<sup>11</sup> While the women were on their way, some of the guards went into the city and reported to the chief priests everything that had happened. <sup>12</sup> **When the chief priests had met with the elders and devised a plan, they gave the soldiers a large sum of money,** <sup>13</sup> **telling them, “You are to say, ‘His disciples came during the night and stole him away while we were asleep.’** <sup>14</sup> **If this report gets to the governor, we will satisfy him and keep you out of trouble.”**

**B. JESUS WAS SEEN ALIVE AFTER HIS DEATH & BURIAL.**

**C. THE LIVES OF THOSE WHO SAW JESUS ALIVE AGAIN WERE CHANGED.**

***LUKE 24:10-12***

<sup>10</sup> It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and several other women who told the apostles what had happened. <sup>11</sup> **But the story sounded like nonsense to the men, so they didn’t believe it.**

**D. THE VOICE OF HISTORY SUGGESTS THAT JESUS WAS RAISED FROM THE DEAD.**

***JOHN 11:25-26***

<sup>25</sup> Jesus told her, “I am the resurrection and the life.<sup>[e]</sup> Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying. <sup>26</sup> Everyone who lives in me and believes in me will never ever die. Do you believe this, Martha?”
