### **ISAAC and JESUS**

- **Isaac** was Abraham's only son.
- **Jesus** was God's only son.
- **Isaac** carried the wood upon which he would be laid & sacrificed (at about 33 years of age).
- **Jesus** carried the wooden cross upon which he would be crucified (at 33 years of age).
- **Mount Moriah** is the place designated by God for Abraham to sacrifice Isaac.
- **Mount Moriah** is the range upon which the city of Jerusalem would eventually be built ... and the location of the crucifixion of Jesus.
- **The Angel of The Lord** stopped Abraham from sacrificing Isaac.
- **The Angel of The Lord is God the Son**, who would later arrive on earth at Jesus the Christ – our Sacrifice for sin.

### **LESSONS WHEN FOLLOWING THE GOD OF ABRAHAM**

- The only real risk is choosing not to follow God's will.
- Faith grows not in the absence of struggle but in the midst of it.
- Life is found in the dying.
