Q: How do I register? A: On our website

Q: When does registration close?A: Registration will officially close July 15th at midnight.

Q: How will we get to camp?

A: Our leadership team will drive the students in Rental vehicles (Most likely they will be 8 passenger SUVs).

Q: Is there a professionally trained medic on site? A: Yes, and they are super nice and helpful when it comes to any injuries, sicknesses and even simply helping students take medication.

Q: What are the sleeping arrangments?

A: We will be in cabins with individual closed stall toilets and heated showers. Students will have access to the cabins throughout the day. The students will sleep in twin sized bunk beds. Please bring bedding to include a pillow, sleeping bag or blankets, and a twin sized sheet. We recommend putting it all in a trash bag with the students name on it to keep it all organized.

Q: Can I bring snacks or food?

A: Yes, but food of any kind is not allowed in the cabins. There will be a snack bar that sells food.

Q: Do you need to be a good swimmer to attend camp?A: No, we have lifeguards watching the students and swimming is optional and typically only at free time.
